



BY-LAW No. A802

**A BY-LAW OF THE VILLAGE OF CONSORT IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA
TO RESCIND PREVIOUSLY ADOPTED BYLAWS**

WHEREAS, the *Municipal Government Act*, being Chapter M-26, as amended, provides that a Council of a Municipality may rescind or repeal a Bylaw; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of Consort deems it expedient and in the public interest to pass such a bylaw;

NOW THEREFORE, under the authority of the *Municipal Government Act* RSA 2000, Chapter M-26, the Council of the Village of Consort duly assembled enacts as follows:

Part 1 - Title

1.1 TITLE

This Bylaw may be cited as the "**Repeal Bylaw**".

Part 2 - Severability

- 2.1** Despite that any section or sections of this bylaw, or any part or parts thereof, may be found by any court of law to be invalid or illegal that section or sections or part or parts thereof, shall be deemed to be severable, and all other sections of this bylaw, or parts thereof, are separate and independent there from and enacted as such.

Part 3 – Coming Into Force and Repeal

- 3.1** This Bylaw will come into force on the date of third and final reading.
- 3.2** That Bylaw A1, A2, 6A, 9A, 10A, 11A, 14A, A16, A17, 19, A21, A22, A24, A29, A32, A33, A35, A44, A56, A58, A66, A67, A69, A71, A73, A74, A85, A86, A89, A90, A94, A95, A95A, 96B, A96, A100, A682 and A674 now are repealed.

Read a third and final time this 12 day of November, 2013.
