
HELMET POLICY:

- ALL HOCKEY PLAYERS UNDER THE AGE OF 18 MUST WEAR A HELMET AND FULL FACE MASK WHEN PARTICIPATING IN SHINNY OR COMMERCIAL HOCKEY.
- ALL OTHER SKATERS UNDER THE AGE OF 18 MUST WEAR A HELMET WHEN PARTICIPATING IN PUBLIC SKATING OR LESSONS.
- ALL COACHES MUST WEAR A HELMET DURING MINOR HOCKEY PRACTICES.
- IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT BEGINNING ADULT SKATERS AND COACHES WEAR A HELMET WHILE ON THE ICE SURFACE.

DISCIPLINE POLICY

DEFINITION OF OFFENSE: UNACCEPTABLE SOCIAL BEHAVIORS AND/OR CONTINUED UNSAFE PRACTICES WHICH ENDANGER THE LIVES OF PATRONS OR THE OFFENDER THEMSELVES.

EXAMPLE:

- Jumping from the bleachers into the cushions
- Climbing on or over the plexi-glass
- Shooting pucks over the boards
- Shooting pucks at others on the ice or in the bleachers
- Anything else deemed unsafe or unacceptable by the staff on duty

First Offense:

- One day suspension from any arena activities
- Phone call to the parents by the Arena Manager
- Detailed written report by the staff on duty and signed by staff and manager, one copy retained by arena, one copy given to the recreation director and if requested, one copy to the parents

Second Offense:

- One week suspension from any arena activities
- Phone call to the parents and a meeting between the parents, child, staff on duty, manager and recreation director
- Detailed written report by the staff on duty and signed by the staff and manager, one copy retained by the arena, one copy given to the recreation director and if requested one copy to the parents.

Third Offense:

- One week suspension from any arena activities including any Minor Hockey games
- Phone call to the parents by the Arena Manager
- Detailed written report by the staff and manager, one copy retained at the arena, one copy given to the recreation director, and if requested one copy to the parents.

All suspensions include lessons, school classes, Hockey games and practice and anything else deemed as arena activities.

CONSORT MINOR SPORTS GOALS & OBJECTIVES

- The goals and objectives of the Consort Minor Sports Association are to ensure that all participants received their participation time in the activity that they have selected to participate in.
- They are to be given the best leadership resources our community should offer.
- It is the Consort Minor Sports Association's ultimate goal and objective to fulfill the bill of rights for athletes. They are:
 - The right to have the opportunity to participate in sports regardless of ability or income.
 - The right to participate at a level that is consistent with the development level.
 - The right to have qualified, sensitive leadership.
 - The right of each participant to share in the leadership and decision-making of their sport.
 - The right to participate in a safe and healthy environment.
 - The right to proper preparation for participation in the sport.
 - The right of all athletes to play as children.
 - The right to have each player have an equal opportunity to strive for successes at their level.
 - The right to be treated with dignity by all involved.
 - The right to have fun through sports.

CONSORT MINOR SPORTS BOARD MEMBERSHIP

- The Consort Minor Sports Board will consist of a minimum of eight members and a maximum of 10.

BOARD GOVERNANCE

CODE OF CONDUCT:

- Board Members will conduct themselves in a calm and respectful manner during meetings. Members deemed "unruly" may be asked to leave the meeting by the President. They may be subject to disciplinary action and asked to leave the board.
- Any letter to be presented to the board must be presented to the president 24 hours prior to the start of the meeting. The President reserves the right to accept any letter within the 24 hours' notice. Upon commencement of the meeting, no further letters will be accepted.
